Board of Directors – Officer Description**

PRESIDENT-ELECT

The order of succession to the duties of the office shall be as follows: president, president-elect, vice-president, secretary-treasurer, immediate past president.

The President-Elect shall:

- Be a member of the American College of Radiology.
- Serve a term of one year.
- Attend all meetings of the Society.
- In the absence or inability of the President to perform all the duties of the office, be directed to assume the duties of the President.
- Assist the President in conducting the business and implementing the policies of the Society.
- Be a member of the Executive Committee.
- Oversee all committees, make sure that the committees are meeting and discussing issues that will be affecting the future of radiology. (Use teleconference whenever it is possible to avoid travel and expenses.)
- Perform such other duties as are prescribed by the Board of Directors.
- Deliver to new President-Elect all materials, and other property of the Society at the close of her/his term.
- Be prepared to serve a one-year term as President, a one-year term Past President and a three year term on the Board of Censors.
